

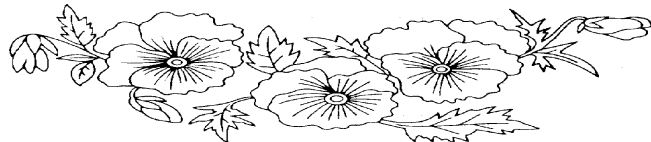
## Purpose of BPAEYC

**From the South:** Take the Garden State Parkway north to exit 168 (Washington Avenue). At the stop sign, turn right onto Washington Avenue. At the first light, turn right onto Pascack Road for approximately 1/4 mile. The YJCC will be on your left.

**From the North:** Take the Garden State Parkway south to exit 166 (Linwood Avenue). Bear right onto Highland Avenue and continue to the stop sign (Linwood Avenue). Turn right onto Linwood Avenue. At the end of Linwood, turn left onto Pascack Road. You will pass the Washington Town Center (shops) on your right about ¼ mile from the YJCC also on your right.
